SAPPHIRE ADJUDGED **BEST CAT IN SHOW**

Captures Leading Honors of Atlantic Club's Exhibition at the Waldorf.

After lively competition, Sapphire, a beautiful blue specimen of feline aristocracy, was yesterday adjudged the best in the show at the eighteenth annual exhibition of the Atlantic Cat Club on the roof of the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel. Sapphire, which has a finely molded head and a sleek coat, was accustomed to the honors thus heaped on him, for in the little more than six years of his existence he has been five times declared the best of the show. He is owned by Miss Elsie G. Hydon of Bogota, N. J., who is well known also as an exhibitor of dogs.

The Atlantic Cat Show was held for the benefit of the Bide-a-Wee Home for

animals, and a good attendance, in spite of the bad weather, made the show profitable for the home. There were 125 cats in the exhibition, some from ancestors in Australia and Siam. They were also of many hucs, with red, white and blue among them to give a patriotic touch.

The closest rival to Sapphire was his own son, Sunset Top Notch, owned by the Misses Champion of Staten Island. While they failed to win in the best of show, the Misses Champion took first in three of the classes. Their Sunset Invincible, a cream colored cat, was best of the Novice Class; their Sunset Peachbloom was adjudged best of the kittens, and their Argent Dazzle was best among the short-haired cats.
